


PROPERTY SURVEY FOR
GARY STRINGHAM
 SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST
 UINTAH SPECIAL BASE AND MERIDIAN



NOTE:
 THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (G.P.S.) PROCEDURES AND EQUIPMENT. THE BEARINGS ARE BASED ON WGS 84 DATUM.

DESCRIPTION OF PARCEL
 Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 10, Township 2 South, Range 7 West of the Uintah Special Base and Meridian, said point being South 0°12'58" West 1138.54 feet from the East Quarter Corner of said Section, said point also being on the South right-of-way line of State Highway 35,
 Thence South 0°12'58" West 647.15 feet along said East section line;
 Thence West 571.93 feet;
 Thence North 29°11'34" East 821.42 feet to said South right-of-way line;
 Thence South 68°04'16" East 187.28 feet along said right-of-way line to the Point of Beginning, containing 6.00 acres.

NARRATIVE
 This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Gary Stringham in order to divide out a 6.00 acres parcel for a home lot. An iron rod with an aluminum cap was found at the Southeast Corner of Section 10 and the original marked stone was found at the East Quarter Corner. These two monuments were used to define the East line of the property. A search was made for highway right-of-way monuments along the South right-of-way line of State Highway 35 but none were found. Mr. Craig Thomas, a long time resident in the area, was interviewed to determine if he had ever seen monuments defining the right-of-way. He stated he had never seen any along this portion of highway and informed us that when the State had improved this portion of the road no new right-of-way had been acquired. We therefore used the old existing right-of-way fence to determine the position of the right-of-way line which is the North line of the surveyed parcel. The west line of the property is offset 1.0 foot East from an existing fence and its extension. The South line was then calculated so as to enclose 6.00 acres.


