


UINTAH INDIAN RESERVATION

NOTES

THE PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY IS TO DEFINE NATIONAL FOREST LANDS.

ALL FOREST SERVICE MONUMENTS ARE 30" ALUMINUM POSTS WITH A 3¼ DIA. ALUMINUM CAP WITH IDENTIFYING "LOGO".

ORIGINAL, RECORD (1903) BEARINGS AND DISTANCES ARE SHOWN IN PARENTHESIS.


CORNER RECORDS FILED SEPARTELY.

BASIS OF BEARING

ALL BEARINGS SHOWN ARE IN PLANE, ANGULAR RELATIONSHIP TO THE BEARING OF THE LINE BETWEEN MP 71 AND MP 71½ AS DETERMINED BY SOLAR OBSERVATION ON JUNE 2, 1987.
