3 **RESOLUTION # 20-12**

4 **A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE DUCHESNE COUNTY TRAILS COMMITTEE**

5 **WHEREAS**, Duchesne County adopted a Trails Master Plan by Resolution #20-07 on October  
6 19, 2020; and

7  
8 **WHEREAS**, the Trails Master Plan recommends the establishment of a County Trails  
9 Committee to work with county staff, stakeholders and land management agencies to implement  
10 the plan; and

11  
12 **WHEREAS**, the Duchesne County Commissioners desire that the Trails Committee consist of  
13 seven members representing a broad geographic cross-section of the County; and

14  
15 **WHEREAS**, the Duchesne County Commissioners seek Trails Committee members who have a  
16 passion for at least one of the following areas of interest: safe routes to schools, road cycling or  
17 mountain biking, OHV or ATV riding, equestrian trails, dirt biking, hiking/walking paths or  
18 paddle boarding; and

20 **WHEREAS**, it is expedient and in the public interest that a Trails Committee be formed at this  
21 time to promote projects that will increase public safety and provide for a wide range of  
22 recreational and physical fitness opportunities in the County.

23  
24 **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Board of Duchesne County Commissioners that:

25  
26 **SECTION 1.** A Duchesne County Trails Committee is hereby formed and shall meet as needed  
27 to implement the Trails Master Plan.

28  
29 **SECTION 2.** The Trails Committee shall consist of seven (7) members; who shall elect a Chair  
30 and Vice Chair at their first meeting of each calendar year.

31  
32 **SECTION 3.** Committee members shall be appointed by the Duchesne County Commissioners  
33 to represent the following areas of the County: Altamont/Upper Country, Duchesne, Fruitland,  
34 Myton, Neola, Roosevelt and Tabiona/Hanna.

35  
36 **SECTION 4.** Committee members shall demonstrate to the Commissioners, in their application  
37 to serve, an interest in at least one of the following types of trails: safe routes to schools, road  
38 cycling or mountain biking, OHV or ATV riding, equestrian, dirt biking, hiking/walking paths or  
39 paddle boarding.

40  
41 **SECTION 5.** Committee members shall serve four-year terms. There is no limit on the number  
42 of consecutive terms that may be served.

43  
44 **SECTION 6.** Committee members shall be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred in serving  
45 the County and shall receive staff support from the Community Development Department.
