

## Regular Board Meeting May 21, 2024 @ 4:30 PM: Roosevelt Library

**Conducting:** Chair Jessica Shaw. The meeting started at 4:30 p.m.

**April 2024 minutes approval.** The board reviewed the April minutes. Jenny Adams made a motion to approve the minutes as written, and Kathryn Crapo 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Duchesne Branch Remodel Update. Everything, including the shelving, has been moved out of the building. The Duchesne County maintenance department and BHI assisted the staff with the move. The flooring was removed. Asbestos tile has been mitigated. Windows have been replaced. The newspaper archive has been moved into the vault. The old shelving collapsed from the weight of the archive. New shelving will need to be purchased. Offsite library services have started.

**New Library Card Design.** The board reviewed the card design options and selected one design. The board suggested pulling colors from the logo into the card design. It will be modified and presented for approval at the next meeting.

**Introduction of Library Event Calendar & Online Room Reservation.** The board reviewed the new online events calendar and room reservation calendar and the process for making reservations. The annual subscription is provided by Library Market. The plan is for it to go live on June 1. Once live, the public will be able to make room reservations online.

**Board Training:** Director Mauchley presented training for the board called "The Library: The Investment of Non-Essential Services." He presented ways that the library helps meet many needs for individuals and the community that may not appear to be essential, life-saving services. They do help the community to grow, improve their well-being, and hopefully help curb demand on other essential services.

**Public comment.** No public comment. King's Peak Credit Union made a donation to the library, which is greatly appreciated.
