

**MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS FOR THE NOVEMBER 5, 2024
GENERAL ELECTION
HELD ON NOVEMBER 19, 2024 AT 11:00 A.M.
IN THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS IN DUCHESNE, UTAH**

PRESENT: Commission Chairperson Irene Hanse, Commissioner Greg Miles, Commissioner Tracy Killian, Commissioner-Elect Jeff Chugg, Clerk-Auditor Chelise Jessen, Election Specialist Cristina Nielsen, and Commissioner’s Executive Assistant Melissa Hughes

The Board of Canvassers convened at the designated place and time.

Duchesne County had two polling locations within the county, one in Roosevelt City and one in Duchesne City. All Registered Republicans were mailed a ballot. All ballots were counted before November 19, 2024, in preparation for the canvass.

There are 10,630 active voters in Duchesne County. 10,630 by mail/Absentee ballots were issued to voters for Duchesne County; 9,067 were counted: 8353 mail or drop box, 541 in person, 21 UOCAVA/disability, and 152 provisional, giving us an 85.3% turnout.

Statistics: There were 55 envelopes with signatures that didn’t match the voter’s signature, 18 envelopes without signatures, and 9 challenged ballots for other curable reasons. All of these envelopes and ballots were unable to be cured. 17 ballots were returned after the postmarked deadline. There were 173 provisional ballots issued; 152 were counted, and 21 were not counted because of insufficient ID. 75 of the provisional ballots were same-day registration.

Commission Chairperson Irene Hansen declares the election official and the results final.
