NOTES OF ORDER AND DEFINITIONS

The following statements pertain to administrative hearings for administrative conditional use permit land use decisions in Duchesne County.

- An administrative hearing is a public meeting conducted by the hearing officer, based on written request by a party having standing and following the hearing officer's determination.
- Hearing participants are limited to: the Hearing Officer, the land use applicant, and owners and/or residents of property located within six-hundred sixty feet (660.00') of the administrative conditional use permit-subject parcel and are recipients of a Notice of Intent to approve a relative administrative conditional use permit.
- An administrative hearing is not an appeal of a land use decision.
- No public comment is taken at an administrative hearing.
- Questions and comments are limited to County Code requirements and the Findings Report.
